BODY SPACE MEDICINE OF ZHI CHEN GUO IN TREATING CANCER. BEST CASES REVIEW STUDY.

A Best Cases scenario study was designed to investigate the role and efficacy of Body Space Medicine of Chinese master healer Zhi Chen Guo in addressing cancer.

Body Space Medicine introduces a new understanding of the etiology and management of cancer. Body Space Medicine distinguishes two kinds of space within the human body. One is the space between cells and the other is the space between organs.

Body Space Medicine offers an unique understanding of the cause of illness. The first major cause is considered to be the abnormal transformation between matter and energy within a cell causing abnormal distribution of energy between cells and the spaces around them.

The second major cause of illness is an imbalance of bodily fluids.

To diagnose abnormal formation and distribution of energy within and outside cells and abnormal distribution of fluid in the body spaces, Body Space Medicine uses a unique tongue reading system.

For healing, Body Space Medicine uses a very limited formulary of Chinese herbs, exercises to unblock and move energy within the body, various unique massage techniques and spiritual intervention. These simple but powerful techniques achieve correction of matter and energy transformation, free flow of energy between cells and the spaces around them, between organs and finally, within energy pathways. Simultaneously, the fluid in the body becomes balanced.

To document the effect of this pioneering healing system on cancer, 15 cases of cancer survivors treated by Zhi Chen Guo between 1999 and 2005 were investigated. Most of these patients were considered to be in such an advanced stage fo cancer that conventional Chinese hospitals declined to treat them any further. The diagnoses included 2 lung cancers, 3 liver cancers, 2 esophageal cancers, 2 pancreatic cancers, and endometrium, ovarian, galbladder and mucosarcoma cancers 1 of each.

In 7 years, 2 out of 15 were dead. Of remaining 13 patients, 75% had estimated Karnofsky in order of 100%. Overall survival was in 5 years 100% and in 7 years 81.1%. In 5 patients, the follow up CT was normal, and in 5 patients, follow up Ultrasound was normal.

The results warrant Stage 2 Clinical Trial in controlled settings.
